
3. Draw a hut, a flower, a joker using geometrical shapes such as triangle, square, rectangle, circle etc.



### Science


1. Make a food chain mobile.

Make picture cards showing various animals and plants. Paste them on strings together as they would be linked in a food chain. Hang them on a frame as in the picture to make a collection of different food chains.



2. Make natural manure at home

- a. Take a flower pot. Put a layer of straw and mud in it.
- b. Add peels of fruits and vegetables, strained tea leaves, egg shells and other kitchen waste (not plastic bags) in the flower pot and cover it. Next day, add some more such kitchen waste into the flower pot and cover with some garden soil.
- c. Repeat the process for a few days till the flower pot is full. Cover it properly and leave it for 15-20 days.
- d. Your humus-rich soil is ready!



3. Watch roots grow

Fill a small jar with water. Put an onion on the mouth of the jar. The base of the onion should touch the water. Watch it for a few days. You will see roots growing from the base of the onion.



4. Write a report on any Indian Bird

Find information and write a report on any Indian bird such as parakeet, mynah, peacock, pigeon, crow, koel etc. Include information such as where it lives, what it eats, the kind of nest it builds, and how many eggs it usually lays.

You can also draw and colour a picture of the bird.



5. Measure your shadows.

You will need a chalk and a measuring tape. Go to a play ground at about 9 in the morning. Draw a small circle in the ground. Stand in the circle. Ask a friend to measure the length of your shadow. Repeat this activity at noon and then at 4.30 in the evening. Record your measurements in the given table. When is the length of your shadow the longest? When is it the shortest?




