MATHEMATICS


> TANGRAM

To make a set of <u>Tangram cutouts</u> by paper folding and cutting and to make geometric figures using its pieces.

Materials required: An 8x8 grid, a pair of scissors, a pen/pencil and a ruler.

Steps:

- 1. Take a 8x8 grid and label it as ABCD, which is a square.[Fig. 1(a)]
- 2. Fold the square ABCD along BD such that point 'C' falls on point 'A' and mark the crease BD.
- 3. Unfold the grid and cut along the crease.
- 4. Take any one cut-out obtained in Step 3 say ABD and fold it through the vertex A so that the two end points of the longest side meet exactly and mark the crease.
- 5. Unfold and cut along the crease and label the two parts as 1 & 2 [Fig. 1(b)].
- 6. Take the other cut-out obtained in Step 3 and fold it in such a way that the point containing a right angle exactly falls on the midpoint of its longest side.
- 7. Unfold and cut along the crease formed. Label the triangle cut-outs as 3 [Fig. 1(c)].
- 8. Take the remaining cut-out obtained in Step 6 and fold along the lines drawn. [Fig.1 (d).]
- 9. Unfold and cut along the creases. Label the cut-outs as 4, 5, 6 & 7. [Fig. 1(e).]



The seven shapes obtained represent a set of tangram pieces.


Extension:



> DREAMCATCHER

Title: Create an Andaman and Nicobar Island-inspired dreamcatcher. Instructions:

- 1. Research the culture and history of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Look for inspiration in the unique art and craft traditions of the region.
- 2. Gather materials to create your dreamcatcher. You will need a hoop or circular frame, string or twine, beads, feathers, and any other decorative elements you may want to add.
- 3. Use the string or twine to create a web inside the hoop. You can use a simple pattern or get creative with different shapes and designs.
- 4. String beads onto the web, incorporating colors and patterns that are inspired by the natural beauty of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- 5. Add feathers to the dreamcatcher. Choose feathers in colors and sizes that complement the overall design.
