Holiday Homework is time for activity and fun. It is an opportunity to spend quality time with your little ones. The students should be encouraged to speak in English at home and revise all the concepts taught in the class.

## **FUN ACTIVITIES**

Be a Friend: Plan a routine together and have open conversations. Play indoor games with your child like—Ludo, Snakes & Ladders, Carroms, etc. and outdoor games like Hide & Seek, Catch, etc. Your child should learn to accept winning and losing. The objective should be to enjoy playing.

Sharpen memory by putting a few things on a tray. Show the tray to your child for a while and then cover the tray. Ask your child to name the objects which were on the tray. This activity helps in enhancing the memory and vocabulary of your child.

## LIFE SKILLS

Inculcate following 'Life skills' in your child to help him/ her become independent.

- Buttoning his/her shirt
- Tying his/her shoe laces
- Keeping his/her belongings in the right place.
- Helping to lay the table for dinner
- Arranging shoes in the shoe rack
- Filling water bottles
- Speaking politely and sharing with siblings and friends



## DEVELOP FINE MOTOR SKILLS

To develop 'Fine Motor Skills' let your child participate in activities like:

- Clay Modelling
- Paper Tearing and Pasting.
- Peeling skin of boiled potatoes and mashing them.
- Opening and closing bottle cap and containers.
- Turning pages of a book carefully.
- Squeezing bath sponges.
- Watering plants using spray bottles.



## MOTHER NATURE

Let's nurture mother nature:

Adopt a Plant: Ask your ward to adopt a sapling. Ask him/her to take care of it and water it timely for a month. Ask him/her to observe the changes. You may take pictures of the plant at every stage and share the same with the teacher.



## OUTDOOR VISITS

Visit places like Railway Museum, Doll Museum, Zoo, Bharat Darshan Park, Bal Bhawan, India Gate during the summer vacations. Have fun and click nice pictures. Then frame these pictures in photo frames made from coloured ice cream sticks.



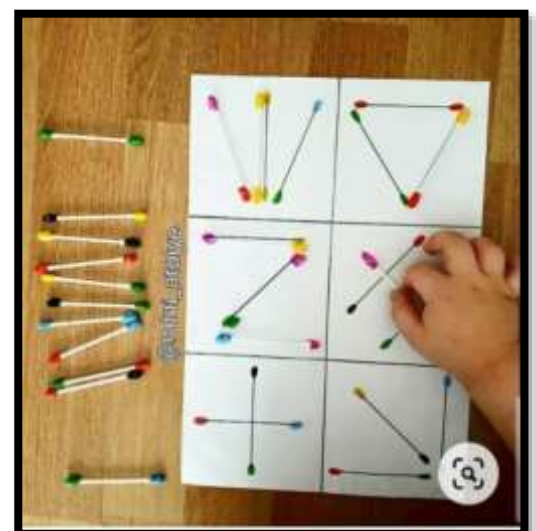
## SPONGE PAINTING
