

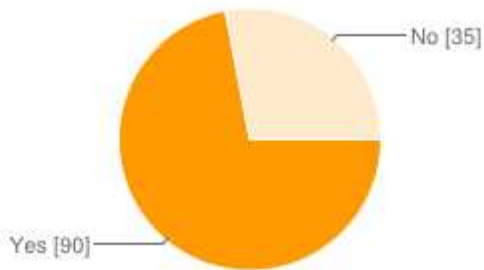

Do you celebrate Independence Day?

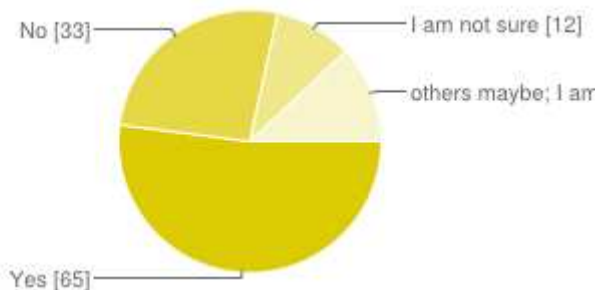

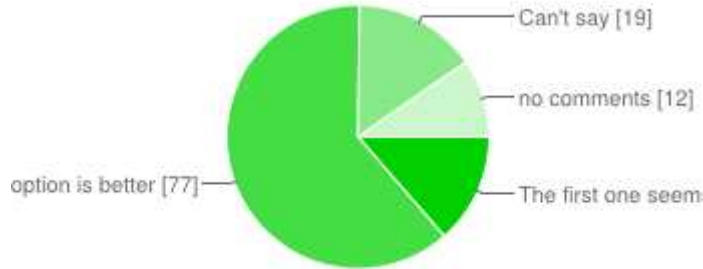

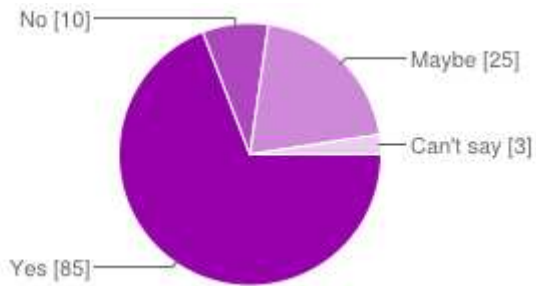

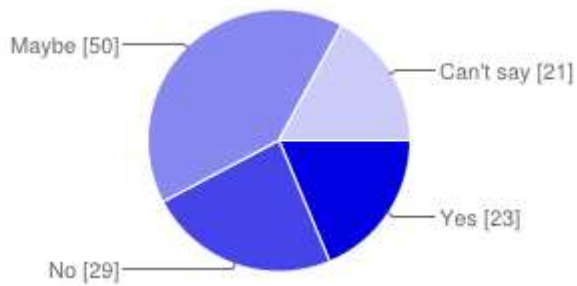

Do you think it would be correct to call India "Incredible"?



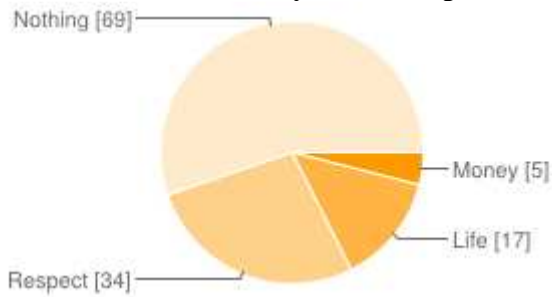

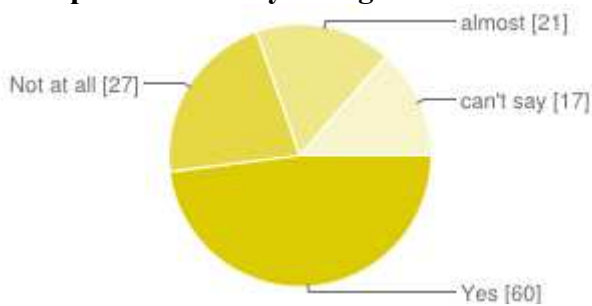
