- Game Concept : Game should reinforce a topic learned and gives the player a better understanding of that topic.
- **Game directions** : All directions should be included and clear to the player of the game.
- **Game Pieces** : Choose or create your game pieces to match your theme.
- Game Packaging : Create attractive packaging for your game. Game should be compactable and must be packed in a box, envelope or a bag.
- **Game Name** : The name of your game, according to theme.
- > Neatness : Neat, organized, attractive, colourful.
