Kindly note that the shared pictures are for reference purpose only. Let the children be as creative and innovative as they want to be.

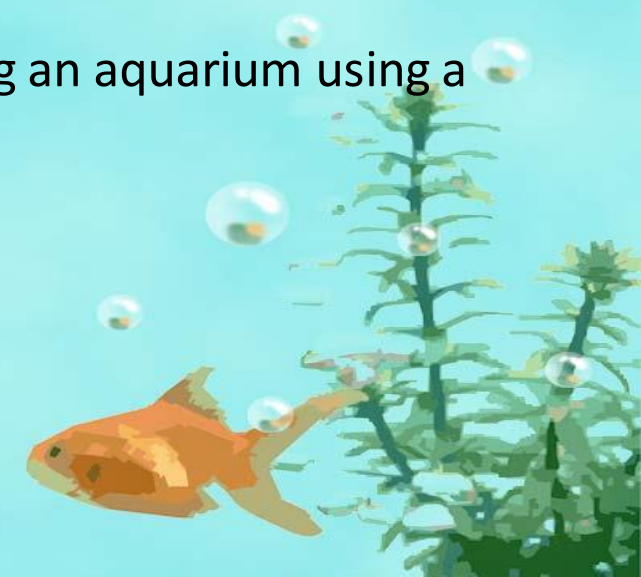
General Awareness
