


- Paste articles/poems/stories about importance of water.

Q5 Write the greatest and the smallest number.


Q6 Find out on which activity the water consumption is more . Write 5 ways how you can save water and can reduce the usage of water for that activity.

- 1. Make your own water filtration system to make muddy water clean again.
- <u>Material required:</u>
- a. Large plastic bottle
- b. Cotton
- c. Cup of sand
- d. Cup of rock/gravel
- e. Cup of activated charcoal
- f. Plastic cup
- g. Muddy water



<u>STEPS</u>

- Cut off the bottom of the plastic bottle with scissors.(keep the cap on)
- 2. Stuff cotton balls into the neck of the bottle.
- 3. Crush the activated charcoal.
- 4. Pour it into the bottle.
- 5. Next add the sand to the bottle.
- 6. Then add the gravel.
- 7. Loosen the cap and set your water filtration system on top of the plastic cup.
- 8. Gently add muddy water into the top.
- 9. Observe what happens as the muddy water is filtered.

<u>Warning: Do not drink this water, it is not filtered</u> <u>enough for drinking.</u>
