## **Dear Parent**

We all are, by now, fully conscious of the difficult times that Coronavirus has posed for the human race. We pray for your safety and wellbeing and request you to 'Stay Home...Stay Safe'.

To ensure that your ward's formal education continues despite temporary closure of schools, we propose to conduct online classes for all students. You would have already received a message in this regard. These online classes will start, as already informed, on Monday, the 06<sup>th</sup> of April, 2020.

The methodology for this online teaching is mentioned below:

- 1. Our teachers are preparing to handle online teaching by creating Word/PowerPoint presentations, assignments, worksheets etc.
- 2. On your part, we request you to immediately equip yourselves with the following minimal infrastructure, which most of you may already be having:
- a) Multi-media Desktop/Laptop Computer or Smartphone.
- b) Microsoft Teams, a software which is well known to many. 'How to download and use Microsoft Teams' on desktop/laptop computers is covered in **Annexure-1**. How to do the same on smartphones is covered in **Annexure-2**.
- c) Schedule of these online classes is placed as **Annexure-3**.
- d) For these online classes to be effective and efficient, we request you to counsel your ward and remind her that all the protocol that they follow in school applies in online 'school' as well. So, please...
- (i) Provide a quiet place where your ward will sit for the online classes. For Classes Seedling, Sapling, I, II & III, we request a parent to be seated along with the child during the duration of the class.
- (ii) Provide basic infrastructure multimedia computer and internet connectivity.
- (iii) Ensure that a notebook and stationery is organised before every class. You may not have the textbooks. But do not worry. We will provide links for e-version of your actual textbooks and of supplementary reading material.
- (iv) Advise them to dress up decently for the classes, not engage in cross chatting with their classmates.
- (v) Please log-in atleast 05 minutes before the scheduled time, and log-out once the session is over.

Please note that these classes are meant only for students of St. Mark's Girls Sr. Sec.School, and they should not share their school log-in IDs with their friends from other schools.
